We are pleased to announce that the XVII International Symposium on Zygaenidae will take place in Karlsruhe (Baden-Württemberg, Germany) from 21-25 March 2022. It will be organised by the State Museum of Natural History Karlsruhe (SMNK) and the Natural History Society of Karlsruhe (NWV).

Scientific board: AXEL HOFMANN, Dr HOSSEIN RAJAEI, Dr ROBERT TRUSCH.

Venue: State Museum of Natural History Karlsruhe (Erbprinzenstr. 13, D-76133 Karlsruhe).

The Symposium will start on Monday evening, 21 March 2022, with welcome addresses by Professor Dr NORBERT LENZ (Director of the SMNK) and Dr ROBERT TRUSCH (Chairman of the NWV) followed by a public introductory lecture by AXEL HOFMANN.

Main topics of the symposium:

1. Zygaenidae as bio-indicators
2. Biology, ecology and distribution of Zygaenidae
3. Results of molecular surveys, taxonomy and systematics of Zygaenidae
4. Reports on recent field studies
5. Presentation of new publications
